


1. Type in www.facebook.com and click enter. Once the Facebook homepage comes up, click "Create New Account."




2. Once you've clicked on "Create New Account," fill in your name, e-mail, birthdate, etc. and then click "Sign Up."




3. Once you are signed up, Facebook will take you to your home page where you can upload a profile picture (if you'd like). It also prompts you to "Find People You Know" and "Get to Know Your Privacy Settings." We recommend you click on "Take a Privacy Tour" so you can learn best how to protect your privacy on Facebook.




4. Follow the Missionaries of Jesus Christ – Edmond page. Go to the search bar at the top of the page and simply type in "missionaries for jesus christ edmond." Then click enter. Your Ward may also have its own page you can follow.




5. After clicking enter, Facebook will take you to the following page (or something similar). Scroll until you see the page circled below and click "Like."




6. Once you've "Liked" the Missionaries for Jesus Christ – Edmond page, click on the blue words "Missionaries for Jesus Christ" to go to their page. Scroll through and enjoy!




7. If you would like to share something you like from the Missionaries' page with your friends, go to that post and click on the "Share" button.




8. Once you've clicked "Share," you will see a number of different ways to share the post. You can "Share Now" (Friends), which will take the post exactly how the missionaries created it and share it to your account so your friends can see it. Or you can click "Share...," which allows you to add your own customized message with the post, as shown below:




9. If you would like to simply "react to" the post or comment on it letting the missionaries know directly what you think of the post, then choose a *reaction* ("Like," "Love," "Care," "Funny," "Wow," "Sad," or "Angry") and/or leave a comment by clicking the "Comment" button and typing in your comment.




10. Don't forget to search for and follow the accounts of each member of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles for more inspirational posts that you can react to, comment on, or share. Be actively engaged. When you do any of these three things (react/comment/share), the post from the Quorum member will appear on your account and your friends will be able to see it.






11. To create your own post for others to see, react to, comment on, and share, go to your profile page, click on the words, "What's on your mind?" and begin typing your message.



12. Best practice is to keep it fairly brief. Once you've finished your message, click "Post" at the bottom, with "News Feed" checked. You will also see an option to check "Story," which will place your post into your "Story." All "Stories" are deleted 24 hours after being posted, so it's usually best to keep it in the "News Feed."



- 13. The Missionaries in our Stake were given guidelines to follow as they began using Facebook to share the Gospel with others. These guidelines are included here for your review. You may find these guidelines helpful as you look to more effectively share the Gospel online.
 - A. Always remember the missionary purpose
 - a. Ask yourself:
 - i. How does this post help invite others to come unto Christ?
 - ii. How does this post help find, teach, and baptize those in my area?
 - B. Use common sense
 - a. Trust in the guidelines given to help us as missionaries do our very best.
 - C. Pray before you post
 - a. Align your will with the Lord's to be the best tool you can be.
 - b. Ask yourself:
 - i. Who of my new friends (or member or less active member) would benefit from this post?
 - ii. Will this post help answer a question I've been asked before?
 - D. Always ask a question and extend an invitation
 - a. When making captions, always ask a question that will help others ponder (such as "why would God allow COVID-19?" or "what's our purpose in life?" or "are families really forever?") and have a desire to act.
 - b. Many people desire the truth, but "know not where to find it." Always add an action such as-- "contact/message us," "find out more at [insert link]."

- E. Use music that will invite the Spirit
 - a. The Church has put out music that will invite the Holy Ghost into their lives through that post.
 - b. Only use music in the Gospel Media, the Sacred Music app, or anything found in churchofjesuschrist.org
- F. "Those things that are sacred ought to stay sacred"
 - a. Ask yourself:
 - i. Will this post help someone feel the Spirit?
 - ii. Am I trivializing something sacred?
- G. Use your talent and creativity to create wholesome, appropriate content
 - a. The Lord has prepared you for this time, and He knows that your specific talents and skills can and will move the work forward.
 - b. Ask yourself:
 - i. How can I use my talents to fulfill my missionary purpose today?
- H. When creating videos, keep them short
 - a. If you are creating a video, try to keep them under 3 minutes. Only 10-15 minutes when doing a live video.
 - b. This will help maintain the attention of the audience, and they won't just scroll past your content.
